Roles & Responsibilities

The Counselor will be part of an effective and caring team and together will respond to various crisis and traumas in the surrounding communities of Oneida, Munsee, and Chippewa. The Counselor will possess the abilities to generate independent decisions but also be capable of working with other team members. Keeping accurate records and reports on a timely basis. The major responsibilities will be assisting in designing, organizing, programming and implementing culturally-based programs and events. The Crisis Intervention Counselor will be under the direction of the Coordinator. He/she will be a part of a Lodge Service Team during Family Healing Programs as well as a part of the Crisis Intervention Team.

Qualifications:

- Must have CPR and First Aid.
- Must have three (3) years of continuous sobriety.
- Must have a valid driver's license, and a reliable insured vehicle.
- Be aware of current mental issues affecting Aboriginal communities.
- Have knowledge of traditional holistic approaches to mental healing.
- Have strong human relations and inter-personal communications skills.
- Be knowledgeable of Aboriginal culture and services offered throughout area.
- Be prepared to work on call-rotating shifts; evenings, weekends and holidays.
- Be prepared to work days and evenings-rotating shifts for the Family Healing Program.
- Have three (3) years related *counseling experience* working with Aboriginal families.
- Have demonstrated commitment to mental healing and wellness of Aboriginal individuals, families and community in whole.
- Have received training at an accredited college or university and hold a Bachelor or Diploma in Health or Social Services or a similar degree in a related field or equivalent work experience.

Other Working Requirements:

- Computer competency is required.
 - To report regularly to the Coordinator.
 - To be available for other duties as assigned.
 - To facilitate circles and meetings when requested.
 - To work with other staff members in a positive manner.
 - To maintain records and files of all clients and organizations.
- *Applicants must clearly demonstrate in a **cover letter** that they meet the above qualifications and must **submit a resume and three letters of work related references**. A job description is available upon request. We encourage Aboriginal candidates to apply.*
